- 3. Auction sales are strictly for cash and must be paid for promptly in United States funds. The coins only become the property of the buyer after full payment. Every bidder is personally liable for his purchases and cannot claim to act for the account of a third person. We cannot assume responsibility for any errors in bidding. PLEASE MAKE CERTAIN YOU BID ON THE CORRECT LOT!
- 4. All floor sales are final and lots cannot be returned for any reason other than authenticity by floor bidders. Any claims for adjustment other than authenticity from mail bidders must be made in writing within 7 days after the delivery of the goods. No lots may be returned without our written permission. It is the buyer's responsibility to have the lots fully insured while in his possession.
- 5. Bidders unknown to the auctioneers are requested to establish credit or deposit 25% of their bids before the sale. 




