2254 **Khorezm Socialist Soviet Republic. Order of Labor of Khorezm People's Soviet Republic.** Screwback. Unnumbered. Silver and brass. Very crudely made, typical for type. Herf 1.22. Kutzenko, Republics, pp. 218-230. Only about 50 issued. *Excessively rare and of high historical importance.*

2255 **Bukharan People's Soviet Republic. Order of the Red Star of Bukhara, 3rd Class.**
Unnumbered. Silver. Green enamel. Medal-like construction, with the loop and connecting ring. Herf 1.24.3, Kutzenko, Republics, pp. 163-192. *Rare*

Condition:

Enamel is 90% off. Very little wear \$ 10,000

2256 **Bukharan People's Soviet Republic. Revolutionary Badge.** Screwback. Un-numbered. Silver with red enamels. 43mm diameter. Original silver nut. Chaghatai legend in Arabic script around crescent and inside the red star. Russian legend „Б.Н.С.Р. Красному Воину 1922“ (People's Republic of Bukhara to Red Soldier 1922). One of the earliest examples of local Soviet awards for struggles against basmachi. Unpublished. Of the high historical significance.

Condition: Minor enamel losses, excellent otherwise. *Extremely Rare* \$ 10,000

 Award # 227. Silver. Enamel. Screwback. Hallmarked. Herf 1.19, Kuts pp. 325-340.
 Only about 200 issued. Awarded to I.A. Safonov on December 11, 1932. Kutzenko,
 Republics, p. 334. Comes with the screwplate with match number. *Rare*

Condition:

Red enamel is 90% off. Practically no wear.
